GAUTHIER SOHO. Set in the unique environment of an unmodernised Regency townhouse in London's vibrant Soho district,

AIRPORT INFO

CHECK-IN. Opens 90 mins before departure & closes 20 mins before departure.

TAXIS. Licensed black cabs are available directly outside the terminal building. Pre-booking is available via Computer Cab. Tel: 020 7908 0286.

BUSES & TRAINS. A pre-bookable shuttle bus runs between Central London and the airport. www.lcysuttle.co.uk. The Docklands Light Railway operates frequent services from the terminal to Canary Wharf and the City.

CAR HIRE. Hertz, Avis and Europcar have licensed offices at the airport which are one minute's walk from the terminal.
